Dental Benefits

Dental benefits are paid at the Scheme Tariff.

Dental benefits are subject to managed care protocols and managed care interventions which may include the requirement of treatment plans and/or radiographs prior to benefit application.

Scheme Exclusions apply to dental benefits.

In the event of a dispute, the registered Rules of the Scheme prevail.

Specialised Dentistry

All Specialised Dentistry benefits for the **Makoti Comprehensive** option are subject to a limit of **R4 011** per family per year. This includes Partial Metal Frame Dentures, Crown & Bridge, Orthodontics, Periodontics and Maxillo-facial Surgery.

Pre-authorisation*

Makoti Comprehensive option: Dentures must be preauthorised.

All options: Hospitalisation and certain Specialised Dentistry procedures must be pre-authorised.

If no pre-authorisation is obtained or if pre-authorisation is applied for after the treatment has been done, benefits will not apply for Crowns, Periodontics, Moderate/Deep Sedation in Dental Rooms and Hospitalisation.

Failure to pre-authorise orthodontic treatment will result in a payment *only* from date of authorisation for the remaining months of treatment, provided that the treatment is clinically indicated.

Pre-authorisation does not apply to emergency hospital admissions.
